Aragon Construction Begins Interior Build-Out At One Rockefeller Plaza

Manhattan's premier general contracting and construction management firm, Aragon Construction, has begun work on a 17,800-square-foot interior build-out at the historic One Rockefeller Plaza for Computer Science Corporation — one of the world's leading providers of information technology services. Working in conjunction with renowned architecture firm Gensler, Aragon is expected to complete the project in mid-September.

Their new space will utilize the entire 27th floor and employ a black, white and red color palette to create a contemporary feel. Walker Zanger tiles have been used throughout the lobby and restrooms, while marble stone flooring will be incorporated at the elevators and reception. Fabric panels, carpet tile, broadloom and glass will also be used to enhance the look and feel of the space.

"The primary goal was to create an impressive experience for Computer Science Corporation's clients as they enter the space," said Project Manager Kathleen Friedle of Gensler. "The use of stone, metal and glass was intended to reflect this modern, technology-driven company."

The prime midtown location will include 15 perimeter executive offices, four conference rooms, three meeting rooms, perimeter work stations, and nine hotelling rooms, which provide traveling employees and clients with a temporary workstation.
