Aragon Construction Set To Rehab Juvie Floors

110 William St. 13th and 14th Floors Under Renovation



Aragon Construction has begun reconstructing two floors of 110 William St. owned by Swig Equities, LLC. Aragon is renovating the entire 13th and a portion of the 14th floors. New York City Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ), occupants of the renovating floors, will be moving temporarily onto the 20th floor.

110 William Street is a 32-story, 900,000-square-foot office building built in 1958. The renovation is set to be only 16 weeks and Aragon looks for it to be completed by mid October. The space will accommodate 47,500 square feet of space.

Aragon Construction has previously worked with Swig Equities on the 15,000-square feet of office built for tenants at 90 Broad.
